

# **Treaty and Aboriginal Rights Research [T.A.R.R.] Centre of Manitoba, INC. Visitor Guidelines**

## **Covid-19 Update to Visitor Policies:**

- 1) Visits to the T.A.R.R. Centre must be scheduled at least 3 business days in advance. A Covid-19 self screening questionnaire will be sent out ahead of time, and must be returned the day before your scheduled visit.
- 2) Face masks are required to be worn at all times (we will not be providing one, so please bring your own).
- 3) Upon entry visitors must sanitize their hands.
- 4) If you are symptomatic, or have been in close contact with someone who is symptomatic or a confirmed case, *please stay home*.
- 5) If you have traveled outside of Canada, or to Eastern Canada within 14 days of your scheduled visit, or been in close contact with someone who has, we ask that you do not visit the T.A.R.R. Centre until 14 days have passed since your return to Manitoba.

## **Other Visitor Procedures:**

Visitors are required to sign in and out of the T.A.R.R. office upon arrival and departure. All bags must be left in an assigned locker for the duration of the visit.

T.A.R.R. does not lend out physical copies of any material under any circumstances. At this time, due to Covid-19 we are also unable to offer our copier.

**Treaty Annuity Paylists:** due to privacy restrictions you are not permitted to photocopy or take photos of any Treaty Annuity Paylists. You may take handwritten notes only. First Nation permission is required to view T.A.R.R.'s available paylists.
